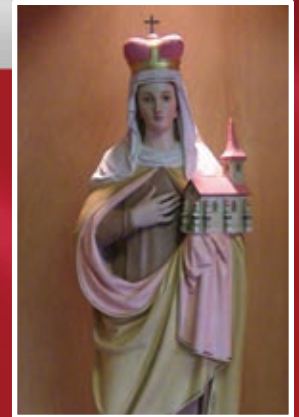

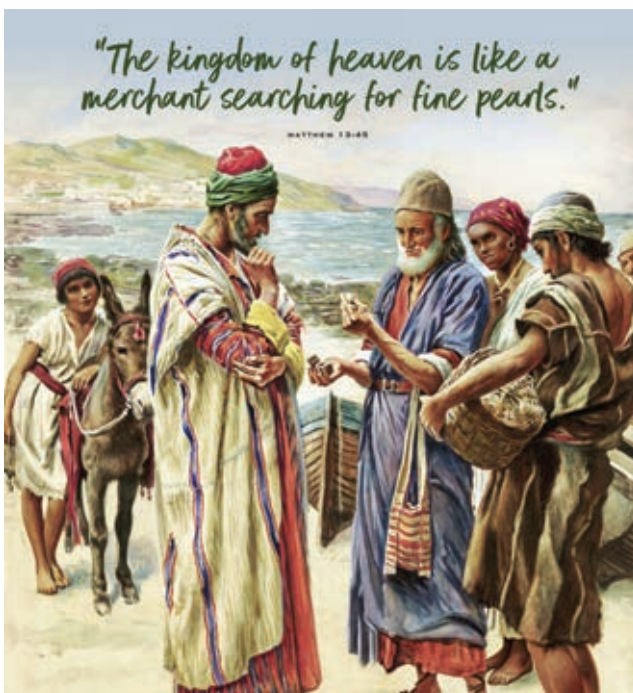

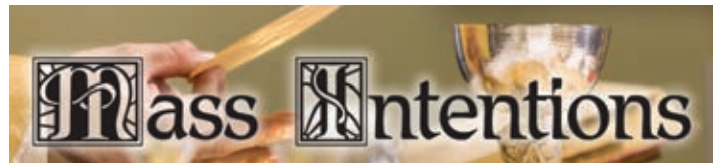

For your safety:

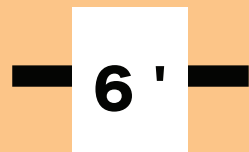


Please Use Hand Sanitizer when entering the church.
